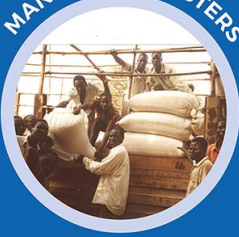


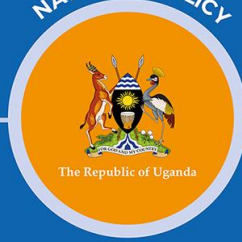
# FROM MANAGING DISASTERS TO MANAGING RISK

## MANAGING RISK

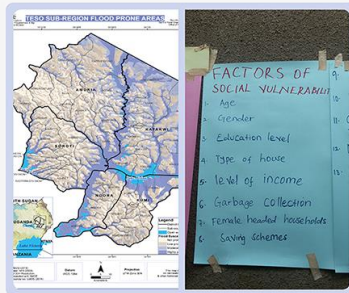


Uganda is realizing risk-informed development through evidence based risk management

### RISK ASSESMENT

#### National identification of hazards, risks and vulnerabilities

- Risk profiles developed for all districts
- Disaster risk reduction integrated into district planning

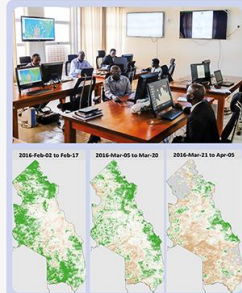

### RISK MONITORING

#### Community-led monitoring

- National centre for coordination and monitoring
- Remote sensing and ICT based monitoring
- Building human capacity



### RISK FINANCING

#### Alternative livelihoods for vulnerable households

- From data to decision: using 'no regrets' indicators for cost effective rapid response
- Evidence based investments targeting vulnerable communities
